Professor Peh is Senior Consultant and Head, Department of Diagnostic Radiology, Khoo Teck Puat Hospital, and Clinical Professor at the Yong Loo Lin School of Medicine, National University of Singapore (NUS). He was formerly Professor of Diagnostic Radiology at the University of Hong Kong. Professor Peh has been the Chief Examiner for the Master of Medicine (MMed) (Diagnostic Radiology), NUS since 2002, is Chairman of the NUS MMed (Diagnostic Radiology) Committee, and has organized the conjoint Final MMed (NUS)-FRCR part B (UK) examinations in Singapore since 2011.

Professor Peh served as Editor of the Singapore Medical Journal for three terms (2004-2009) and is currently Advisor. He was past Editor of Proceedings of Singapore Healthcare and Founding Editor of the Hong Kong Journal of Radiology. He is currently Senior Editor of the British Journal of Radiology. His Editorial Board memberships (past or current) include journals such as Radiology, American Journal of Roentgenology, Skeletal Radiology, Seminars in Musculoskeletal Radiology, and American Journal of Orthopedics.

He was the Founding President of the Asian Musculoskeletal Society (1999-2003), inaugural 1998 Radiological Society of North America Editorial Fellow, inaugural 2000 and 2001 ASEAN Association of Radiology Visiting Professor, 2003 International Skeletal Society President's Medallist, 2007 Japanese Society of Musculoskeletal Radiology Katayama Lecturer, 2010 Singapore Medical Association Merit Award recipient, 2015 Musculoskeletal Society of India Karkala Subbarao Orator, 2017 Singapore Radiological Society—College of Radiologists Singapore FY Khoo Memorial Lecturer, and the 2017 Singapore Ministry of Health Distinguished Senior Clinician Award recipient.

To date, he has authored 8 books, more than 60 book chapters, more than 380 PubMed-listed journal publications, and has delivered more than 900 invited lectures. He has been the organizing chairman of several scientific examination writing workshops, radiology preparation courses. musculoskeletal teaching courses, and regional and international radiology congresses, including the 32nd Annual Scientific Meeting and Refresher Course of the International Skeletal Society held in Singapore in 2005. He was Asian coordinator for the International Skeletal Society Regional Outreach Programme from 2003 to 2016, organizing a total of 18 musculoskeletal radiology workshops for young radiologists throughout Asia. He is currently serving as Immediate Past President of the Asia-Pacific Association of Medical Journal Editors.
