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Bile Duct Cancer: Overview

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Bile duct cancer is like a bane of radiologists. It includes various megascopic types and often demonstrates the micro-skip lesions along the biliary tree or invasion directly into the hepatic parenchyma. Curative treatment includes only a surgical resection based on the accurate diagnosis of tumor extension. Recently intraductal papillary neoplasms of the bile duct (IPNB) has been newly added in the pathological classification and demonstrates a number of interesting imaging findings. In this JSMRM-KSMRM joint symposium, Korean and Japanese experts would give talks about IPNB and cholangio cancer regarding the pathological concept, imaging findings, and how to manage these pathologies.
